POSITION PURPOSE

UNIQUE ASPECTS TO THIS POSITION
<p>The Premier Team Coach must be able to demonstrate the skills and techniques of soccer. He/She must be able to articulate and communicate soccer tactics. The position requires an outgoing personality with the ability to work with players, parents, volunteers, and DOC. The Premier Team Coach must possess the desire to excel and believe in the goal of Spokane Shadow Youth Soccer Club becoming the premier club in our community and state.</p>

JOB DUTIES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Coach Shadow team(s), embracing the club's philosophy and promoting unity within the club and community. 2. Develop players and assist with other team(s) in same age group. 3. Help construct Shadow age group training priorities and prepare players for next division, level, and age group. 4. Make strong effort to get successful results in training and games. 5. Recruit best players in the Inland Empire, following proper recruiting rules. 6. Take part in all Shadow Coaching Education Clinics/Meetings. 7. Work with Director in all areas, but specifically player selection/placement/movement. 8. Conduct a minimum of two formal parent meetings each season. 9. Produce a minimum of two player evaluations each season. 10. Organize all team related activities (e.g. tournament registration, travel arrangements, etc.) with volunteer Team Manager. 11. Communicate effectively and promptly with club, players, team managers, and parents 12. Assist with tryouts throughout all ages. 13. Contribute articles to club newsletter, website and other PR/Marketing efforts. 14. Create and maintain a positive environment for players and parents. 15. Perform other duties as assigned.
